



MAGNETIC GRAPHICS TIP SHEET

The magnet is more pliable and easier to work with when air temperature is at least 60° F.

SURFACE PREPARATION:

The magnetic graphic and painted surface must be clean and dry.

APPLICATION:

Magnetic graphics hold best to flat surfaces and surfaces reasonably curved in one direction. If the magnet is placed in the wrong position, remove the magnet and realign. **DO NOT pull the magnet to reposition**, damage to the magnet (stretching) and painted surface (scratching) will occur. Make sure the entire magnet is against the surface, no air pockets. **Cooper Flags** cannot be held liable for lost or damaged magnetic graphics due to improper installation or care.

CLEANING:

To protect the clear coat on new cars, we recommend daily removal of magnetic graphics. Moisture and dirt will collect between the magnet and surface if left in place for long periods of time. Remove and clean both the magnet and surface with a mild cleaner, allow both surfaces to dry before reinstalling. We do not recommend applying magnetic graphics to repainted surfaces.

STORAGE:

The best way to store the magnetic pieces is either flat or rolled, never magnetic surface to magnetic surface. When storing rolled, roll with face out to avoid the possibility of wrinkles.
